

## Advisory Note for Pre-marriage Long-Term Visit Pass (LTVP) Assessment

Marriage to a Singapore Citizen (SC) does not guarantee the Non-Resident (NR) spouse automatic right of entry into Singapore or approval for long-term immigration facilities.

This free online pre-marriage LTVP assessment facility will give the SC-NR couple greater clarity in planning their future together. An SC who intends to marry a NR can check whether the intended NR Spouse is likely to be eligible for LTVP through this free pre-marriage LTVP assessment facility.

Couples who are successful in their assessment will be issued with a Letter of LTVP Eligibility (LLE) and may proceed to apply for the LTVP after they are legally married.

### Important Notes

- (a) This online Pre-Marriage LTVP Assessment facility has to be completed in English.
- (b) It comprises of two parts – Part 1 to be completed by the SC while Part 2 to be completed by the intended NR spouse.
- (c) The SC requires a SingPass account to access this online facility. To apply for a SingPass, please visit <http://www.singpass.gov.sg>. A reference number and password will be generated after Part 1 has been completed by the SC.
- (d) The intended NR spouse can use the reference number and password to view the information furnished in Part 1 of the form before proceeding to complete Part 2 of the form. The intended NR spouse is required to declare that he/she has viewed and read the information furnished by the SC in Part 1.
- (e) The SC can use his SingPass to retrieve the completed form. The SC is required to declare that he/she has viewed and read the information furnished in Part 2 by the intended NR spouse before submitting the completed form for ICA's assessment.
- (f) The completed assessment form must be submitted electronically to ICA within 14 days from the point of generation of the reference number and password. Assessment forms not submitted to ICA within 14 days will be automatically withdrawn.
- (g) Each Part of the form may take about 15 minutes to complete. The SC and the intended NR spouse will need the following information to fill up the form:
  1. Bio-data particulars such as date of birth
  2. Residential address including details of residential property
  3. Immigration records, including passport details and travel history
  4. Marital status history (where applicable)
  5. Educational qualifications
  6. Income information
  7. Medical information (where applicable)
  8. Criminal records (where applicable)

- (h) The SC and intended NR spouse have to declare that all the particulars furnished in the assessment are true and correct. Any false statement and/or declaration made by the SC and intended NR spouse in relation to the pre-marriage LTVP assessment may render the assessment result invalid.
- (i) The processing time for the Pre-Marriage LTVP Assessment is up to 4 weeks.
- (j) The outcome of the assessment and a copy of the completed form will be mailed to both the SC and the intended NR spouse at the residential or mailing addresses declared in the assessment form.
- (k) Couples who are successful in their assessment will be issued with a Letter of LTVP Eligibility (LLE). The LLE is valid for 1 year. The LLE does not constitute the approval of a Long-Term Visit Pass (LTVP).
- (l) An application for a Long-Term Visit Pass (LTVP) still needs to be submitted if the NR spouse intends to reside in Singapore for the long term after the SC-NR couple has been legally married. The SC can submit a formal application for LTVP for the NR spouse, at <https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/esvclandingpage/evp>.
