This is only applicable to those who are 21 years old and above. <input type="checkbox"/> Prepare all documents required for the Registration of Singapore Citizenship. <input type="checkbox"/> Report to ICA Building on the date and time stipulated in the notification letter to register for Singapore Citizenship (typically 3-4 weeks from date of the letter) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Typically, the Ceremony will be held 3–6 months after successful applicants have completed Stage 3. <input type="checkbox"/> The Pink Identity Card (also known as NRIC) and SC Certificate will be presented to you at the Citizenship Ceremony that is specially organised to welcome all new citizens! |
